
One of the top choral ensembles in Asia, Formosa Singers is a regular medalist at international choir championships and is celebrated all over the world.

On Wednesday, September 19, the Cities of Orange City, Alton, and the NW IA Area Landfill will co-sponsor a HHM Recycling event from 4–6 pm at the Orange City Street Department building. This building is located just south of Ace Hardware. The address is 809 Concord Place SE. Acceptable items include:

- degreaser
- waxes/polishes
- solvents
- lacquers/thinners
- caustic cleaners
- stain removers
- pesticides/herbicides
- oil based paints (latex paints will be assessed a \$1/gal. fee.)

The Sioux County Regional airport is a joint effort of the communities of Orange City and Sioux Center.

Paving is complete on the 5,500 sq. ft. runway with the final major paving being the parking



lots. The footings for the  $100 \times 100$  ft. hangar are complete and the building will be going up soon. The airport is looking great and nearing completion with opening projected for late 2018.



# new sewer treatment plant is nearing completion

There is a lot of activity at the site where the new sewer treatment plant is being constructed. The majority of the work is completed and the tanks are in the process of leak testing. Finished grading is almost

complete and the gravel drive and fence will soon be installed. The external building is complete with the generator, transformer, & air handler installed. All electrical conduits are installed and electricians are finishing up the wiring into the electrical room. Finally, the blower pads and blowers are installed. The plant will go on line in the fall of this year. The project has gone smoothly and is on schedule.
