The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 27.6 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 71.1% of the 27,878 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 22.2%, renter occupied; and 6.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 26,697 housing units in the area - 73.1% owner occupied, 20.5% renter occupied, and 6.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.94%. Median home value in the area is \$144,436, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.33% annually to \$162,090.
