JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: Electric Line Maintenance Worker II

REPORTS TO: Electric Department Supervisor

PRIMARY PURPOSE:

The Electric Line Maintenance Worker II is accountable to the Electric Department Supervisor and performs all work associated with the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of all the City's electrical distribution system, transmission lines, and services.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Helps with the overall construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of all the City's electrical distribution system, transmission lines, and services.
2. Works in a manner to produce efficient use of equipment, and keeps equipment and area in good repair.
3. Performs all work in a safe manner following all federal and state safety rules and the City of Orange City requirements.
4. Perform standby duties in rotation with others.
5. Overtime work is required occasionally.
6. This position might require working in other departments according to need.
7. Attends and participates in job safety and other safety programs.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, EXPERIENCE:

Requires completion of an accredited High School or a GED. Must have successfully completed an accredited Lineman School. Must have a driver's license with a good driving record and be able to obtain an Iowa CDL license. Must have the ability to receive orders and instructions. Must have a good mechanical aptitude. Must be able and have the initiative to work without close supervision. Must be patient, courteous, and friendly.

PHYSICAL AND COGNITIVE REQUIREMENTS:

The physical demands here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to: lift and carry heavy objects, considerable walking and standing. Some pulling, pushing, stooping, kneeling and reaching.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Considerable exposure to oil, dirt, water and weather extremes. Exposure to heights, confined spaces, and major exposure to energized line hazards.
