Current average household income is \$80,011 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$86,424 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$30,343 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$32,838 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 71.2% of the 28,333 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.7%, renter occupied; and 7.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 26,694 housing units in the area - 73.1% owner occupied, 20.5% renter occupied, and 6.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.68%. Median home value in the area is \$156,641, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.98% annually to \$172,764.
