The latest mural in Orange City is finished, or nearly so. Artist Mark Alsum designed & painted the mural on the east wall of First Impact. The mural is dedicated to the memory of Joyce Bloemendaal, long-time director of Orange City Arts. Thank you, Joyce, & to those who began the Orange City Arts Council, for this legacy of arts, beauty, & richer lives.

Funding is by Orange City Arts and private donors... with assistance from Diamond Vogel Paint & First Reformed Church, owner of First Impact. The funding goal is \$5555 by August 15, and 55 percent was reached by July 15. orange city area daycare addition is making progress

Construction continues on the Orange City Area Daycare addition. A \$1.8 million dollar addition is being constructed to nearly double the size of the Daycare Center. This will give Orange City Area Daycare the ability to serve additional children, eliminate the waiting list,

expand the partnership with MOC-Floyd Valley, and provide opportunities to partner with the Northwestern College Early Childhood Program. The project is on track to be completed in early December of this year. With the completion of the addition, the Daycare Center will be able to serve approximately an additional 100 full and part-time children.

changes to downloadable ebooks and audiobooks

1000 books before kindergarten graduation

Our first 1000 Books Before Kindergarten graduation ceremony will be held on Monday, August 17, at 6:30 pm. Any child registered for the program who has read all 1000 books by that date is invited to attend! The 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program attempts to promote reading to newborns, infants, and toddlers and to encourage parent and child bonding through reading.



Participants in the 1000BBK program read and record any 1000 books (even repeats!) that they read before entering Kindergarten. While 1000 books seems like a lot, reading just 1 book a day for 3 years or 3 books a day for less than one year will get you to your goal! Stop by the library to sign up a child and get all of your materials.

iowa window tinting standards

Iowa law prohibits a person from operating a motor vehicle that is equipped with a front windshield or a side window to the immediate right or left of the driver (front side window) which does not meet a standard of transparency of 70% light transmittance. Effective July 4, 2012, no exemption may be granted from the 70% standard.

Medical exemptions signed by a physician, chiropractor, or optometrist prior to July 4, 2012, remain valid subject to the following conditions: A motor vehicle fitted with a front windshield or a front side window with less than 70 percent but not less than 35 percent light transmittance before July 4, 2012, may continue to be operated with a front windshield or a front side window with less than 70 percent but not less than 35 percent light transmittance on or after July 4, 2012, so long as the vehicle continues to be used for the transport of a passenger or operator who obtained Form 432020, which documented a medical need for such reduced transparency, and was signed by the person’s physician before July 4, 2012. Form 432020 must be carried at all times in the vehicle to which the exemption applies. At such time as the vehicle is no longer used for the transport of the passenger or operator who is the subject of Form 432020, the exemption expires and may not be renewed. The owner of the vehicle to which the exemption applied must return the vehicle to conformance with the minimum standard of transparency within 60 days of expiration of the exemption.
